





Ivy Hall Sensory Dispensary officially opened to the public on Friday, April 28. Locally-owned Village Grind Coffee & Tea provided free coffee, and Donuts and pastries were provided to customers by Harner's Bakery as well. Customers were lined up out the door before 9am anxiously awaiting to see the space and their special free cannabis gift. The interior decor, the laid-back vibes, the unique ancillaries they have to offer, and the friendly and approachable staff are what sets Ivy Hall apart from its counterparts. Their goal is about destigmatizing Cannabis and the consumption of it, and enhancing the experience through education and awareness, all while meeting the consumer wherever they're at in their cannabis journey with a welcoming environment.

Ivy Hall is recreational only and is 61% black-owned, making it a social equity dispensary; the first social equity dispensary to serve the western suburbs and its surrounding communities. Montgomery is the 4<sup>th</sup> store location to open since their induction in November '22 in the Bucktown neighborhood of Chicago.




